

50/50 RAFFLE: OFFICIAL RULES

OFFICIAL RULES

By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of Speedway Children's Charities (hereafter "Sponsor"), which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the raffle. The raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

NET PROCEEDS

Net proceeds are split between the winner and Sponsor.

PRIZE

The prize shall consist of fifty percent (50%) of the net proceeds collected from eligible ticket sales during the raffle period, subject to state law maximum cash prize limitations.

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

Tickets are available for purchase during the dates and times designated by the Sponsor.

Tickets may be purchased online or in person, as specified by the Sponsor, in participating states where permitted by law.

Participants must be (i) at least twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of purchase, and (ii) must be physically located within the state(s) where ticket sales are legally authorized at the time of purchase. Void where prohibited.

Volunteers, employees, directors, officers, shareholders, members, temporary or contract employees, and agents of Sponsor, Speedway Motorsports, LLC, and each of their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, and advertising or promotional agencies (collectively, the "Released Parties") and immediate family members and members of the household of such employees are not eligible to win.

PURCHASING ENTRIES

The raffle sales period, pricing structure, and ticket quantities will be announced by the Sponsor prior to the start of ticket sales.

Ticket purchases are considered voluntary donations and are final. No refunds will be issued. Tickets may be purchased only through authorized sales channels designated by the Sponsor.

DRAWING AND SELECTION

The winning ticket number will be selected using a certified random number generator or other legally compliant random selection method approved by applicable regulations. The drawing will occur at a time designated by the Sponsor following the close of ticket sales.

ATTENDANCE AT DRAWING

Ticket holders do not need to be present at the time of the drawing to win or to claim a prize.

CLAIMING THE PRIZE

The winner must provide full legal name, address, phone number, and valid government-issued identification in order to claim the prize. The winner may also be required to complete a publicity release, where permitted by law.

Winners will have thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the drawing to claim the prize. If the prize is not claimed within this timeframe, the ticket will be deemed void, and the prize amount will be retained by the Sponsor for charitable purposes.

For security reasons, no cash payments will be made. Prizes will be paid by check within sixty (60) calendar days after verification of eligibility and completion of required documentation.

FRAUDULENT OR INVALID TICKETS

Unauthorized persons copying, selling, or altering tickets are subject to prosecution. A ticket will be void and no prize will be awarded if there is proof that the ticket was stolen, unissued, ineligible, altered, counterfeit (in whole or in part), defective, duplicated, or issued in error.

DETERMINATION OF OFFICIAL WINNER

The Sponsor shall have sole discretion to determine whether a potential winner is an official winner. Sponsor's decisions are final and binding.

To be declared an official winner, the potential winner must:

1. Meet all eligibility requirements under these Official Rules;
2. Not be in violation of these Official Rules; and

3. Respond to Sponsor communications and complete all required documentation, including but not limited to a winner affidavit of eligibility, applicable IRS forms, and a liability/publicity release, within the specified timeframe.

If the above requirements are not met the prize will be forfeited and donated to Sponsor.

TAXES AND LEGAL COMPLIANCE

All applicable federal, state, and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. For U.S. residents:

- Any winner must complete IRS Form W-9.
- A winner of any prize equal to or exceeding \$600 will receive on or before January 31st of the immediately following calendar year an IRS Form W-2G setting forth the amount of the prize and the withholding amount (if any).
- For prizes exceeding \$5,000, required federal withholding will be deducted in accordance with IRS regulations.

For non-U.S. residents:

- Any winner must complete IRS Form W-8BEN.

A winner of any prize will receive on or before March 15th of the immediately following calendar year an IRS Form 1042-S Applicable withholding rates will be applied in accordance with all federal, state and local tax laws.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The Sponsor and its service providers are not responsible for:

1. Tickets that are lost, stolen, damaged, illegible, destroyed, or no longer in the purchaser's possession;
2. Tickets that have been tampered with or resold in violation of these rules;
3. Entries or payments that are delayed, misdirected, undelivered, or not properly processed due to technical failures of any kind, including network, server, internet service provider, website, telephone, mobile device, or other equipment issues;
4. Errors of any kind, whether human, typographical, printing, mechanical, or electronic, relating to or connected with the raffle, including errors in processing entries, identifying winners, or delivering prizes.

If, in the Sponsor's sole judgment, the raffle is compromised by virus, unauthorized intervention, technical failure, or other causes that affect the administration, security, fairness, or integrity of the raffle, the Sponsor reserves the right to suspend, modify, or terminate the raffle and select a winner from all eligible entries received prior to the disruption.

All ticket purchases are final. The Sponsor has the sole and final authority regarding eligibility determinations and winner selection.

Sponsor reserves the right to make changes to these Official Rules, which changes will become effective upon publication of revised.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

By participating, entrants agree that the Released Parties shall have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless against, any claims, losses, liabilities, damages, or expenses arising out of participation in the raffle or acceptance, use, or misuse of the prize, including but not limited to personal injury, death, or property damage. Released Parties (i) make no warranty, guaranty or representation of any kind concerning any prize, and (ii) disclaim any implied warranty. Each entrant agrees that (i) any and all disputes, claims, controversies or causes of action arising out of or relating to a raffle, or any prizes awarded (each, a "Claim"), shall not be consolidated or joined with or in any other proceeding involving a Claim of any other party; (ii) his/her sole and exclusive remedy for any Claim against Sponsor arising out of the sale of tickets or the conduct of the raffle shall be limited to the return of the purchase price paid for his/her ticket(s); and (iii) in no event shall the Released Parties be liable to any party or entrant for any loss or injury to earnings, profits or goodwill, or for any incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages of any person or entity whether arising in contract, tort or otherwise, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.
