

**Celebrity Blackjack Tournament**  
**Friday, October 18**

**3 Round 32 Team Format**

- 8 tables with four teams of three plus one celebrity
- 32 Teams of 3 (1 team member plays each round)
  - 96 fans and 8 celebrities
- 3 rounds of 20 hands
- Each spot at the table gets 5,000 in tournament chips at the start of each session
  - After each session, the next player adds their 5,000 chips to their team's remaining stack (*i.e. if Bob finished with 2,000 chips, John adds his 5,000 chips to the stack and their team now has a 7,000 chip count*)
  - Drivers/Celebrities are reloaded each round with 5,000 in tournament chips
- Chip counts will be shown on TVs in the tournament area

**Buy in/Entry Fee**

- \$1500 for a team (3)
  - 96 players x \$500 = \$48,000

**Prize Money**

Prize Money for Participants (Leaves \$35,000 for Charity):

- 1<sup>st</sup> - \$6,500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$4,000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2,500
- 4<sup>th</sup> – Dinner for Two to Silverado Steak House or Don Vito's and Two Showroom Headliner Tickets (one for each player)
- 5<sup>th</sup> – Dinner for Two to Baja Miguel's or Primarily Prime Rib and Two Showroom Headliner Tickets (one for each player)

Prize Money for Winning Celebrity's Charity:

- \$5000 - *South Point will Pay*

Rules:

- Participant Seating Assignments For The Tournament Will Be Pre-Drawn
- **ALL** Players Will Receive 5,000 In Chips: (2) \$1000, (2)\$500, (20) \$100
  - To Expedite Transitions, Provide Celebrities With A Chip Rack Containing The 5,000 Before The Round Begins.

**Celebrity Blackjack Tournament**

- Celebrities Will Get A 5,000 Chip Top Up Each Round
- Standard 8-Deck Shoe With A Hand Shuffle
- Split Any Pair Up To Four Hands
- Double Down On Any 2 Cards
- Blackjack Pays 2 To 1
- Minimum Bet \$100 | Maximum No Limit
- No Side Bets
- If A Player Is Out Of Chips Before The End Of The Round, They Are Out
- Final Table
  - After the Third Round the Top 5 Teams Proceed to Final Table – They Will Need Chip Racks
  - Teams Will Draw for Position at the Table, Use a Separate Deck for This
  - Dealer Button - A Dealer Button Will Be Used To Determine Order Of Betting Only. Once Established, The Player To The Left Of The Dealer Button Will Bet First. Betting Will Proceed To The Left Until All Players Have Placed Their Bet. The Last Bet Will Be Made By The Player With The Dealer Button. Once A Bet Is Placed Inside The Betting Circle, The Bet May Not Be Changed. A Player Betting Out Of Order Will Be Required To Keep The Same Bet.
  - Order of Betting Will Proceed Clockwise
  - If Two Teams Go Bust On The Final Table On The Same Hand, Whoever Bet More Finishes Higher.
- Tournament Chips Have No Cash Value
