

FAQs:

Is the event rain or shine?

Light rain, yes! Downpour, no. We'll reach out to participants if weather will affect the event as it gets closer.

Is the event good for teens?

Yes! This mini-session is a great opportunity for licensed? teens (16+) to strengthen their handling skills, and learn how to maneuver while maintaining control.

Do I need a special type of car?

Nope! Our expert instructors have experience with nearly every type of vehicle, and will offer a free safety tech inspection prior to the course.

Will my car be damaged?

As long as your car is in good working order and drivers adhere to safety protocol, it's unlikely your car will sustain damage on the course.

Is autocross safe?

If done correctly, yes! The course is created with cones, meaning there's nothing in the vicinity to hit. Although, enough cones down will dock time off your final score!

Are helmets provided?

Yes, participants can bring their own, or borrow one of ours.

Can I bring a passenger?

No passengers, but family and friends are welcome to watch you on the sidelines!

Will we drive on the race track?

During this time, the road course will be undergoing a repave and will not be accessible. The autocross driving course will be located on the paddock surface, behind the Main Grandstand.

Are spectators free?

Yes.

Can I purchase a registration as a gift?

Yes, just as long as the recipient is a licensed driver over 16 years old.
