



TRACK LAPS RULES and FAQs

- Track Laps **Rules**
 - Waivers: Adult and minor waivers must be completed (adults have the option to print waiver on registration form and deliver on-site, minor waivers will need to be completed on-site by parents)
 - Drivers must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license
 - Vehicles must be street legal
 - All participants **MUST** wear a seat belt
 - Vehicles **MUST** stay in-line and behind the pace vehicle -- NO passing!
 - **REMAIN** in your vehicle at all times
 - **WAIT** for Nashville Superspeedway track vehicle to lead you onto track
 - **NO** stopping on track
 - **NO** side-by-side racing
 - **NO** following to close to other cars
 - 70 mph speed limit
 - **MAINTAIN SPEED** -- No slowing down and speeding up
 - **BE AWARE** of other cars in front of you and behind you
 - **EXIT** when directed after laps are complete
 - No motorcycles, open-air vehicles, tractor-trailers, recreational vehicles, etc., may be used for track laps
 - Vehicles deemed unsafe by event staff will not be allowed onto the track
 - We reserve the right to remove any vehicles from track/facility that are not adhering to the rules and/or are being disruptive to the track laps experience without refund

- Track Laps **FAQs**
 - *Can my **family** be in the car?* Yes, seat belts must match the number of persons in the vehicle
 - *Is the **\$75 per person**?* No, per vehicle (three-lap sessions)
 - *If I purchase two **three-lap sessions**, will laps be **consecutive**?* We will run three-lap sessions and six-lap sessions based on purchase (subject to change)
 - *Are **helmets** required?* Helmets will not be provided and are not required
 - *Are **convertibles** allowed?* Yes, but top must remain closed (no open-air vehicles)
 - *How many **vehicles** will go at a time?* Groups of approx. 15 vehicles at a time
 - *When/how will I get my **Victory Lane photo**?* All participants will receive a link to view the photos after the event
 - *Do I need to arrive at a specific **time**?* No, you may arrive between the hours of 10 a.m. - 1 p.m.
